



Uniform Policy

The staff and governors at Cron dall Primary School expect that all children will look smart and wear clean appropriate uniform at all times. Children are expected to keep their shirts tucked in and hair looking neat and tidy. Please ensure that shoes are clean and polished. We ask that ALL items of clothing are clearly named to allow any lost property to be returned to the appropriate child.

Boys

- White polo shirt – plain, OR white polo shirt with embroidered school logo
- **Year 6 ONLY** – White shirt with school tie (ties available from school office)
- Grey trousers (boys may wear grey shorts in summer term)
- Grey socks
- Black school shoes (no trainers)
- Red sweatshirt with embroidered school logo – crew neck or v neck (**Year 6 MUST wear v-neck**)
- Reversible fleece lined jacket or waterproof coat (not compulsory)
- Summer and winter hats
- Red school book bag (Yr R & 1)
- Black school book bag (Y2 +) (not compulsory)
- Black school backpack (Y2 +) (not compulsory)
- PE – house colour shirt
- Black shorts
- PE bag – house colour
- Trainers for PE (summer)
- Named water bottle (available from the school office)

Girls

- White polo shirt – plain or white polo shirt with embroidered school logo
- **Year 6 ONLY** – White shirt with school tie (ties available from school office)
- Grey trousers, or grey pinafore, or pleated grey skirt
- Summer term – girls may wear red checked dress
- White or grey socks (red, grey or black tights may be worn in winter)
- Black school shoes (no boots, slip ons or trainers)
- Red sweatshirt with embroidered school logo – crew neck or v neck or cardigans
- Reversible fleece lined jacket or waterproof coat (not compulsory)
- Summer and winter hats
- Red school book bag (Yr R & 1)
- Black school satchel (Yr 2 +) (not compulsory)
- Black school backpack (Y2 +) (not compulsory)
- PE – house colour shirt
- Black shorts
- PE bag – house colours
- Trainers for PE (summer)
- Named water bottle (available from the school office)

Hair

Boys and girls whose hair goes beyond their collar are required to tie their hair back. No large elaborate hairbands or bows.

Jewellery

Due to Health and Safety regulations ONLY plain stud earrings are acceptable in school (please see picture below). Earrings should be removed by the child or covered by surgical tape which is kept in each classroom. A watch may be worn, but no other jewellery (e.g. rings, bracelets, necklaces) are allowed. Nail polish is also not permitted.
